



tmux Sessions

<code>tmux new-session -s session_name</code>	Start a new session
<code>tmux attach-session -t session_name</code>	Attach to an existing session
<code>CTRL-B D</code>	Detach from the current session
<code>tmux list-sessions</code>	List existing sessions
<code>tmux switch-client -t session_name</code>	Switch to a different session
<code>tmux rename-session -t old_name new_name</code>	Rename the current session

Panes Management

<code>CTRL-B %</code>	Split the current pane horizontally
<code>CTRL-B</code>	Split the current pane vertically
<code>CTRL-B Arrow keys or CTRL-B O</code>	Navigate between panes
<code>CTRL-B CTRL-RightArrow</code>	Enlarge the current pane horizontally
<code>CTRL-B CTRL-LeftArrow</code>	Shrink the current pane horizontally
<code>CTRL-B CTRL-DownArrow</code>	Enlarge the current pane vertically
<code>CTRL-B CTRL-UpArrow</code>	Shrink the current pane vertically
<code>CTRL-D</code> (when not running any programs)	Close the current pane

Copy Mode

<code>setw -g mode-keys vi</code>	Use vi keys in buffer
<code>CTRL + B [</code>	Enter copy mode

Windows Management

<code>CTRL-B C</code>	Create a new window
<code>CTRL-B N</code>	Switch to the next window
<code>CTRL-B P</code>	Switch to the previous window
<code>CTRL-B 0-9</code>	Switch to a specific window
<code>CTRL-B , (comma)</code>	Rename the current window
<code>CTRL-B &</code>	Close the current window

Session Management

<code>CTRL-B C</code>	Create a new session
<code>CTRL-B N</code>	Switch to the next session
<code>CTRL-B P</code>	Switch to the previous session
<code>CTRL-B (number)</code>	Switch to a specific session
<code>CTRL-B D</code>	Detach from the current session
<code>CTRL-B \$</code>	Rename the current session
<code>CTRL-B S</code>	List sessions

Variables

<code>#(date)</code>	Shell command
<code>#I</code>	Window index
<code>#S</code>	Session name

CTRL-B D	Detach from the current tmux session.
CTRL-B ?	Display the tmux help window.
CTRL-B Z	Toggle pane zoom (enlarge/shrink the current pane).
CTRL-B [Enter copy mode for scrolling through the terminal output.
CTRL-B]	Paste the copied text from copy mode.

Note: Please note that when using **tmux**, keystrokes consist of two parts: a prefix and a command. The prefix, typically **CTRL+B** (C-b), needs to be pressed and released first, followed by quickly pressing the desired command. This two-step process allows you to execute specific actions in **tmux**. For instance, the shortcut **CTRL-B C** signifies that when you press **CTRL-B** together and then release them, followed by the **C** key, **tmux** will create a new window in the current session.
